

Visitation

1,049 visitors signed in during September, 67.8% more than in September 2000. We had 34 visitors from 11 other countries with Kenya (7), Germany (6), Holland (4), Argentina (3), and Australia and India (2 each) heading the list. New countries added to this year's list were Bolivia and India. We had 270 visitors from 31 other states with Arkansas (59), California (30), Texas (20), Missouri (16), Kansas (13), and New Mexico and Ohio (12 each) at the top of the list. We had 745 visitors from Oklahoma. 28 of the foreign visitors were first-time visitors, along with 203 of out-ofstate visitors and 444 Oklahomans. Year to date, we have had visitors from 49 states, Washington D.C., 3 U.S. possessions and 46 other coun-Vermont is still the tries. missing state. Of the 8,193 visitors so far this year, 56.8% were first-timers, 83.8% of foreign visitors, 73.3% of visitors from other states, 46.8% of Oklahomans, and 100% from Guam.

This month more visitors came on Monday, Friday, Saturday, and Sunday, totaling 79.8% of our visitors. 83.9% fo visitors came between 11:30 and 5:30pm. We had one day with only 1 visitor and another day with only 2.

Visitor comments included: "Wonderful place, keep up the good work!" A Venezuelan, "Chevere". "Where's rain?", "Wonderful God's Big Acre", "Great informative host", "Im-"Inspirational", pressive". very informative-"Staff wonderful place", A visitor from Turkey wrote, "Doesn't look like home. I am happy to find this preserve." Another person commented, "I want to ride my horse through the country and sing Oklahoma." Some folks saw "2 great owls, a covote, and BISON." There were also many "great, beautiful, wonderful, interesting, nice, and excellent" comments.
